What does your child need to bring?

- Wet weather clothing and named welly boots are mandatory. It is really important that children bring their welly-boots, so often children come without them..... please provide waterproof trousers if you have them - we will still go outside whatever the weather!
- **Winter layers, hats & gloves** as appropriate.
- Please ensure that all items are clearly named! As normal we will keep lost property to the next Holiday Playscheme and then we will find a home for it. If you lose anything please get in touch asap via email: holidayclub@mohaircentre.co.uk
- Please provide your child with a healthy packed lunch, along with a named water bottle. We provide a healthy snack and drink at break-times. PLEASE NOTE WE ARE A NUT-FREE ENVIRONMENT
